Black History Month

4.1 Black History Month Subcommittee

The Black History Month Subcommittee noted that the youth librarian at Port Moody Public Library has provided information on Black Canadian arts and authors who could be profiled and featured, and that the Subcommittee is currently awaiting approval from the City's Communications staff.

Staff noted the following:

- the City's Communications staff recommend partnering with the Library, which is also planning a similar feature;
- the Library's content can be re-posted on the City's Instagram and Facebook accounts with a specific reference to the Committee's recognition of Black History Month, with a link to information gathered by the Committee; and
- staff will work with the Library and the Subcommittee on the language of the social media content by email.

Pink Shirt Day

4.2 Pink Shirt Day Subcommittee

The Pink Shirt Day Subcommittee noted the following:

- this year's focus will be on a social media campaign, similar to Orange Shirt Day;
- it will involve a photo collage of students holding up letters to spell "Stop Bullying", and posted on the City's Instagram account;
- letters will be assigned to those who are interested in participating; if less than 12 people sign up, then some participants can do more than one letter;
- the Subcommittee is targeting the posting date of Monday February 22, 2021; the Subcommittee will create the collage and a write-up, and send it to staff the week prior;
- participants can hold up the letter without showing their face if they wish;
- the Subcommittee will also encourage people to wear pink shirts on February 24, 2021; and
- the Subcommittee Chair will send an email to recruit participants.
