Subject: Proclamation - Day of Action Against Anti-Asian Racism

On April 27, 2021, my office received the attached email from Doris Mah, Burnaby resident and SWAG organizer regarding Day of Action Against Anti-Asian Racism Proclamation.

Unfortunately given the agenda deadlines, this would not make it on an agenda in time to be considered by Council prior to the proclamation date. Therefore I am asking Council to consider this item at the April 27, 2021 Council meeting.

Stand With Asians Coalition (SWAC) is a community of people in Canada who are concerned about the surge of anti-Asian racism in our cities. A recent federally-funded study reported 1150 cases of racist attacks in Canada last year.

With recent events around the world regarding the surge if anti-Asian racism, I am in full support for declaring May 10, 2021 as the Day of Action Against Anti-Asian Racism in the City of Port Moody.

I recommend the following:

THAT the City of Port Moody Council declare May 10, 2021, as the "Day of Action Against Anti-Asian Racism" in the City of Port Moody.
