Subject: Funding Source – 2021 Canada Day Celebration

At the Special Council meeting held on April 20, 2021, Council considered a report dated March 23, 2021 from the Community Services Department – Cultural Services Division regarding Proposed 2021 Canada Day Celebration (**Attachment 1**) and passed the following resolution:

CW21/051

THAT staff plan a virtual Canada Day celebration as outlined and recommended in the report dated March 23, 2021 from the Community Services Department – Cultural Services Division regarding Proposed 2021 Virtual Canada Day Celebration;

AND THAT funding of \$4,500 be approved and forwarded to the Finance Committee for identification of a funding source;

AND THAT staff report back with options and costs for participating in the drive-thru Golden Spike Days event.

The budget of \$4,500 for the virtual 2021 Canada Day celebration is now before the Finance Committee for identification of a funding source. Staff recommend Council Contingency as a funding source, which has a current uncommitted balance of \$11,274. The recommended resolution is:

THAT the budget of \$4,500 for the virtual 2021 Canada Day celebration be funded from Council Contingency as recommended in the memo dated April 26, 2021 from the Finance and Technology Department – Financial Services Division regarding Funding Source – 2021 Canada Day Celebration.
