Subject: *Metro 2050* Regional Growth Strategy – Opportunity to Request Update from Metro Staff

The purpose of this memo is to bring forward an opportunity to invite Metro staff to an upcoming Committee of the Whole Meeting to provide an update on the development of the *Metro 2050* Regional Growth Strategy (RGS).

Metro 2040 was accepted by member jurisdictions in 2011. In 2019, Metro Vancouver initiated an update to *Metro 2040*, which is focussed on: building on its successes and learnings to date; updating growth projections to 2050; aligning the RGS with *Transport 2050*; and integrating climate change and social equity considerations. Following policy reviews in 2019-2020, proposed changes to the plan are now being reviewed with the Metro 2050 Intergovernmental Advisory Committee, which includes staff from all member jurisdictions.

As part of engagement and outreach on *Metro 2050*, Metro staff have been presenting to member Councils to provide updates, indicate challenges and opportunities being explored, and answer questions. If Council is interested, Metro staff can be invited to provide a *Metro 2050* update at an upcoming Committee of the Whole Meeting in June. Once a full draft of *Metro 2050* is completed, Metro staff will also be presenting to member Councils, currently anticipated to take place later this year between September and December.

THAT Metro staff be invited to an upcoming Committee of the Whole Meeting to provide an update on the development of *Metro 2050* as recommended in the memo dated April 27, 2021 from the Community Development Department – Policy Planning Division regarding *Metro 2050* Regional Growth Strategy – Opportunity to Request Update from Metro Staff.
