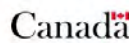

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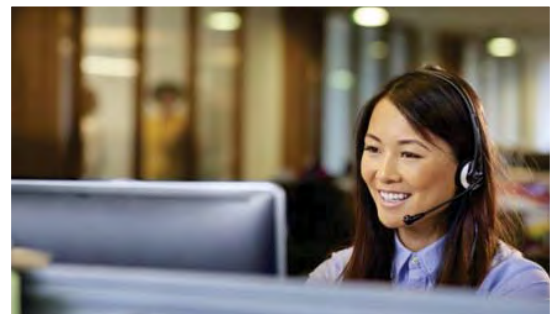

Rebates – Eligibility Criteria

- Eligible homes include: Single family, side-by-side rowhome or duplex, mobile home on permanent foundation
- Rebate values dependant on **primary space heating system prior to upgrade**
 - **Note:** A natural gas or propane fireplace is never considered a primary heating system.
- **Rebates cannot exceed the cost** of the upgrade and may only be claimed once
- Maximum of 1 primary space heating rebate; **cannot** get both a heat pump and natural gas furnace rebate
- Homes primarily heated by Electricity supplied by BC Hydro must meet the **Minimum Electricity Consumption Requirement** (<https://app.bchydro.com/hero/eligibility>)

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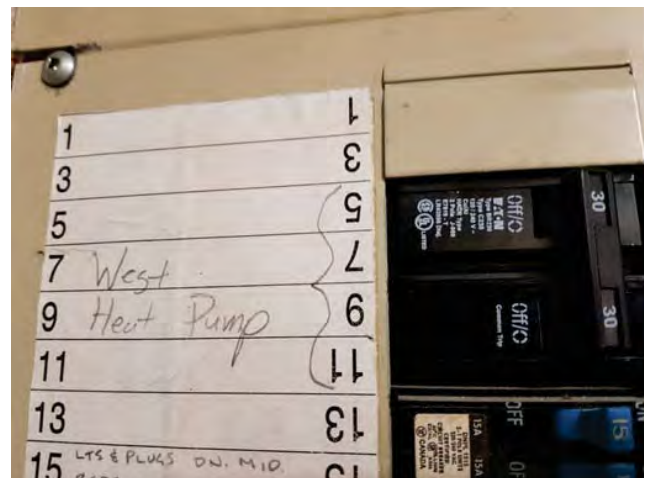

Electrical Service Upgrade Rebate

- \$500 rebates for upgrading electrical service to 100, 200, or 400 amp service
 - When in combination with any heat pump space heating or water heating rebate for system that were previously fossil fuel fired equipment.
- Municipal top ups may also be available

Heat Pump Group Purchase Rebate

The Heat Pump Group Purchase Rebate (GPR) is an additional rebate offer that rewards groups of homeowners working together to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by switching from an oil, natural gas, or propane heating system to an air source heat pump. Participants are encouraged to spread the word about their heat pump purchase group, as the larger each group becomes, the larger the rebate will be. The Group Purchase Rebate ranges from \$200 per home, for a group of 2 homes up to a maximum of \$500 for a group of 20 to 30 homes. The Group Purchase Rebate is additional to the individual air-source heat pump rebate of up to \$3,000 available from CleanBC and any local government top-ups that may be available.

- The GPR rewards groups of homeowners working together **to switch from natural gas, oil or propane heating to an air source heat pump.**

GPR Rebate Amount Based on Group Size

- GPR amount is based on the final group size, the rebate is paid out as a separate rebate cheque mailed to the applicant (second payment). Amount is determined once the code has expired.

Available Rebates

The size of the rebate a participant can access depends on the size of the group using the same GPR Code.

Size of Group	Each Participant Receives
2-4 homes	\$200
5-9 homes	\$275
10-14 homes	\$350
15-19 homes	\$425
20-30 homes	\$500

- The [CleanBC Better Homes and Home Renovation Rebate Program](#) is offering \$3,000 heat pump rebates for fuel switching from fossil fuel to a heat pump in addition to the Group Purchase Rebate.
- Select municipalities have [Municipal Offers](#) of up to an additional \$2,000 that can be accessed only when converting from fossil fuel heating (natural gas, oil, or propane) to an electric air-source heat pump.

- ☐ **Step 3: Complete Upgrades**
Have your contractor install your heat pump. Find contractors online at BetterHomesBC.ca/PRC.
- ☐ **Step 4: Submit Application**
Submit your heat pump application online at App.BCHydro.com/HERO. Include your GPR Code in the Promotional Code field. Submit your application before your GPR Code expires!

- Upgrades **must** be installed by a **Finance Registered Contractor**.
- You must have a residential utility account with FortisBC, BC Hydro or a municipal utility.
- Your home must be **primarily heated** with:
 - Natural Gas
 - Propane
 - Oil
- Premises primarily heated by wood or other solid fuels are not eligible.

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Heat Pump Rebates: Electrically Heated Homes*

- Electrically heated homes must meet a **minimum electricity consumption** to be eligible.
 - Check eligibility by entering your BC Hydro account number and home's square footage at bchydro.com/hero/eligibility

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Upgrade Your Natural Gas

- Natural gas replacement rebates are available to homeowners looking to upgrade their current natural gas primary space heating systems.
 - Homes currently heated by electricity cannot access natural gas primary space heating rebates.**
- Primary space heating systems count as one upgrade towards the bonus offers

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Water Heating and Windows and Doors

- Water heater rebates available for both natural gas systems and heat pump water heaters
- Window rebates are funded both in part by the Utility Providers and the CleanBC Program.
- Water heaters count as one upgrade for the bonus offers
- Windows and Doors when the rebate achieved is at least \$250 counts as one upgrade for the bonus offers

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Insulation Rebates

- Insulation rebates are based on the improvement of R-value added into a given space.
- Each location has their own calculation to determine rebate amount
- All insulation categories when the rebate achieved is at least \$500 can count towards the bonus offers.
 - Other insulation does not apply

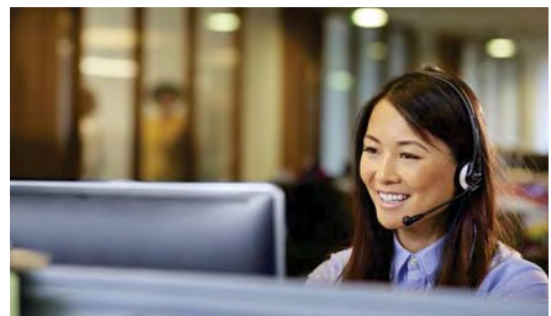

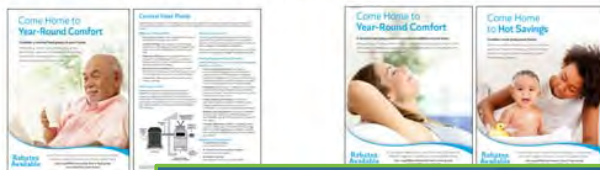

Getting Started with GPR in Your Community

Program Guide Heat Pump Group Purchase Rebate

Step 2. Start or Seed a Group

- Interested stakeholders are able to start a group even if they are not personally installing a heat pump in their home. This will allow local governments, contractors, community groups and others to start a GPR group. Those groups can start (seed) a group by registering [here](#). Be sure to sign up as a Contractor, Community Organizer, or Municipality if you are looking to 'seed' a group.
- The administration will not count the 'seeder' as an active participant, and therefore not count towards group size. Only homeowners that register for a GPR Code, install an eligible heat pump, and receive the rebate will count towards the total group size.
- Reminder:** Codes are valid for 90 days from the date the group is formed. When homeowners join an existing group they make sure they have enough time to install an eligible heat pump and apply before the code expires. The GPR Code includes the Expiry Date, noted in the confirmation email you will receive.

Launch a GPR Group in your community by:

1. Read through the GPR Program Guide
2. Email the Community Energy Coach for resources and information on promoting the GPR and CleanBC rebates
3. Register for the GPR by starting a new 'seeded' group

- Promote the GPR generally without the use of a Code
- Encourage members of the community to start their own groups
