




- A safe active transportation route on loco Road and First Avenue would encourage people to ride, walk and run to Belcarra Park and Sasamat Lake.




• People park as far away as the loco Townsite and walk to the lake, creating an unsafe situation for drivers, pedestrians and cyclists.






ncouver Regional Greenways 2050 Plan
