Date:July 12, 2021Submitted by:Community Development Department – Economic Development OfficeSubject:Funding Request for 2021 Spike Business Awards

The purpose of this memo is to seek Council approval for up to \$10,000 for the 2021 Spike Business Awards gala.

At the June 22, 2021, Regular Council Meeting, Council approved the recommendation by the Economic Development Committee (EDC) to move the Spike Business Awards recognition of winners to BC Buy Local Week, which in 2021 is from November 29 to December 3. The report (**Attachment 1**) noted that there was no decision on the format of the awards distribution and that the EDC would return to Council with a funding request for an in-person event if it could be held.

At the July 7, 2021 EDC meeting, the committee passed the following resolution:

#### EDC21/013

THAT the Port Moody Galleria and Inlet Theatre be booked for the 2021 Spike Awards Gala on December 1, 2021;

AND THAT the funding request of \$10,000 to hold the 2021 Spike Awards Gala event be approved.

The gala would be held if two conditions were fulfilled. First, BC would need to be in <u>Step 4 of</u> <u>the ReStart plan</u>. The earliest this could happen is September 7, but as delays in activating Step 4 is conceivable, for the purposes of planning this event, the Province would need to be in Step 4 no later than October 1, 2021. Second, the City's Galleria and Inlet Theatre would need to be booking public events for gatherings of this size. December 1, 2021, has been tentatively booked for the Spike Business Awards gala.

The funding request for up to \$10,000 is based on the average net expense for the last three years the gala has been held, 2017 to 2019, of \$7,428.25. The higher request is for contingency for any price increases as there are unknowns with respect to demand for these types of goods and services for the first holiday season since the pandemic and recognizing that the event has traditionally been delivered on a very lean budget. Staff will still strive to secure goods and services at the best value possible.

The EDC strongly supported holding a gala in 2021 to celebrate Port Moody's business community after a challenging COVID-19 period. 2020 winners would also be acknowledged during the event as there was no gala last year.

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The recommended resolution is:

THAT up to \$10,000 be approved for the 2021 Spike Business Awards gala to be held during BC Buy Local Week, contingent on 1) the Province having moved into Step 4 of the ReStart Plan by October 1, 2021, and 2) the City allowing events in the Galleria and Inlet Theatre, as recommended in the memorandum dated July 12, 2021 from the Community Development Department – Economic Development Office regarding Funding Request for 2021 Spike Business Awards;

AND THAT the budget of up to \$10,000 be referred to the Finance Committee for identifying a funding source.

To seek Council approval on the Economic Development Committee's (EDC) request to modify the timeline for the Spike Business Awards program for 2021.

2021 will be the 16<sup>th</sup> year of the Spike Business Awards, Port Moody's signature event recognizing the City's business community in six categories: Arts in Business, Environmental Leadership, Inclusive Excellence, New Business, Young Entrepreneur, and Business of the Year.

For the past two years, the selection process has involved the following steps:

- 1. sending notification to businesses (**Attachment 1**) and informing the public that the nomination period has opened;
- 2. shortlisting of finalists from among the nominations by the EDC Spike Business Awards working group;
- 3. requesting additional information from finalists to supplement nominations;
- 4. selecting winners by the EDC; and
- 5. presenting the awards.

Steps 2 to 5 typically occur within a four or five week period and logistics are compressed.

The EDC is recommending that the presentation be held during BC Buy Local Week, which takes place around the last week of November and into the first week of December, rather than Small Business Week in October, when the awards have typically been distributed.

The rationale is to accommodate a slightly longer nomination period, to provide the Committee adequate time between receiving documentation from finalists to the selection of winners, and to serve as a reminder during the critical holiday period to support local enterprises.

At this time, the format for the presentation of the 2021 Spike Business Awards is still undecided given regulatory uncertainty and appetite for in-person events and budget considerations. In 2020, due to COVID-19, the event was a scaled-down version consisting of members of Council presenting to the winners at their place of business. Should the EDC recommend an in-person event, a subsequent memo will be sent to Council with a funding request.

The recommended resolution is:

THAT Council approve the revised Spike Business Awards timeline as recommended in the memo dated June 3, 2021 from the Community Development Department – Economic Development Office regarding 2021 Spike Business Awards Timeline.
