Subject: Peaceful Assembly

On October 5, 2021, Council considered an update to the Parks and Community Facilities Rules and Regulations Bylaw to address:

- housekeeping amendments such as staff title changes, definition corrections, and formatting;
- Council direction to reduce the group gathering size from 50 to 30 people as the limit to gather in any park unless authorized by written consent of the General Manager of Community Services; and
- inclusion of peaceful assembly as a permitted use.

During Council discussion, a concern that the Bylaw was not successfully achieving the desired peaceful assembly changes was raised. While the intent of the Bylaw presented on October 5, 2021 was to remove barriers for peaceful assembly, staff have reviewed the Bylaw again and are recommending a few additional amendments to remove any areas where the intent could be misinterpreted. The recommended amendments include a change in text to section 5.1 to specifically exempt a demonstration or major demonstration, and a deletion of text in section 5.3.a. A changes tracked version of the Parks and Community Facilities Rules and Regulations Bylaw is included as **Attachment 1**, and a clean version of the Parks and Community Facilities Rules and Regulations Bylaw is included as **Attachment 2**. Staff recommend that third reading of the Bylaw be rescinded, and that the Bylaw be read a third time as amended.

The recommended resolutions are:

THAT third reading of City of Port Moody Parks and Community Facilities Rules and Regulations Bylaw, 2021, No. 3321 be rescinded as recommended in the memo dated October 21, 2021 from the General Manager of Community Development regarding Peaceful Assembly;

AND THAT City of Port Moody Parks and Community Facilities Rules and Regulations Bylaw, 2021, No. 3321 be read a third time as amended.
