At the Regular Council meeting held on November 23, 2021, Council considered the attached report dated November 5, 2021 from the Community Development Department – Policy Planning Division regarding 2022 Cool It! Climate Leadership Program Funding Request and passed the following resolution:

*RC21/478 (Consent)*

THAT \$6,300 be approved to fund seven elementary and three high school Cool It! Climate Leadership Workshops for 2022 as recommended in the report dated November 5, 2021 from the Community Development Department – Policy Planning Division regarding 2022 Cool It! Climate Leadership Program Funding Request;

AND THAT the budget of \$6,300 be forwarded to the Finance Committee to identify a funding source.

The budget of up to \$6,300 approved to fund seven elementary and three high school Cool It! Climate Leadership Workshops for 2022 is now before the Finance Committee for identification of a funding source. Staff recommend Council Contingency as a funding source.
