1. Business

Mayor Vagramov opened the Public Hearing at 7:03pm.

Councillor Royer declared a conflict of interest due to her family business and left the meeting at this point and did not return.

Bylaw No. 3328, a Bylaw to designate the Moisio Residence, the Siddall Residence, and the Sutherland Residence at 2130 St. George Street, 123 Douglas Street, and 2133 St. Andrews Street as Protected Heritage Properties.

Mayor Vagramov read the meeting procedures.

The Corporate Officer introduced the proposed Bylaw and confirmed that the statutory requirements for this Public Hearing were met and no correspondence was received by the advertised deadline.

Councillor Lubik entered the meeting at this point.

Staff gave a presentation on the Bylaw, including information about the heritage designation and images of the residences.

Mayor Vagramov called for public input.

Fred Soofi (Port Moody) expressed support for the Bylaw, noting that the relocated homes are now providing housing for local residents. Mr. Soofi suggested that the City publicly share information about upcoming housing demolitions to promote and encourage heritage preservation.

Gaëtan Royer (Port Moody) expressed support for the Bylaw, noting that the homes have been authentically restored and thanked Council for supporting heritage preservation.

Mayor Vagramov called three more times for public input. There was no more public input.
