Report considered at the January 11, 2022 Council meeting: Community Development Department – Policy Planning Division, dated December 6, 2021

Bylaw No. 3336, a Bylaw to amend City of Port Moody Zoning Bylaw, 2018, No. 2937 to include Accessible Detached Accessory Dwelling Unit (DADU) regulations.

Mayor Vagramov read the meeting procedures.

The Corporate Officer introduced the proposed Bylaw and confirmed that the statutory requirements for this Public Hearing were met and that no written public input was received before the advertised deadline.

Staff gave a presentation on the proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment.
