- Port Moody could be promoted as a walkable city with desirable patio spaces, tourist destinations, and access to rapid transit;
- Destination BC's tools and tourism industry information could be used to guide planning efforts;
- improvements to the signage, boat launch area, trail system, and fencing at Rocky Point Park could be undertaken in preparation for a high volume of visitors should the pandemic continue; and
- self-guided walking and environmental tours could be developed for Rocky Point Park.

The Chair advised that the City is scheduled to begin the engagement process related to the Official Community Plan Update and encouraged Committee members to participate in the process to ensure the needs of the residents and the Committee are considered in the update.
