- Date requested for lighting: August 7th, 2022. Alternatively, August 4-5-6 or 8 of August is possible if August 7th is already booked.
- Description of cause/event: This will be the 11th edition of World PVNH Disorder Awareness Day to support more than 750 families affected by PVNH and other neuronal heterotopia disorders in Port Moody, across BC and beyond in 38 countries overall. PVNH is a rare neurological disorder that causes epilepsy in up to 90% of affected individuals. It often involves multiple problems with other organs and can sometimes be fatal if symptoms are left untreated. - Have you made the same request to other iconic facilities? If yes, which ones? Last year, we had 59 landmarks in 5 countries supporting our cause by lighting, including Jack Pool Plaza, Science World, City Hall, Sails of Light and BC Place in Vancouver alone. This year, we've already confirmed 5 in Perth, Australia: Matagarup Bridge and other surrounding landmarks, as well as BC Place, Sails of Light and Bloedel Conservatory in Vancouver, BC Canada, as noted on our website. Many more are pending confirmation.
- Is this an annual or one-time event? Annual since 2012.
- What colour(s) are you requesting? Pink : colour code #e44398 and yellow #ffff33 if possible, or either colour in only one is permitted.
- Please provide details of how you will promote your event, and where mention will be made of the lighting. We have landmarks promoted internationally using our website, social media platforms (4 for PVNH Support & Awareness / 3 for PVNH Day and 4 for Yolaine Dupont, founder) and with press releases. We also sometimes get airtime. Families around the globe (in

38 countries) will also be sharing about their PVNH journey in social media ahead of and on August 7th.

Thank you for considering our request again this year. We would be proud to see Port Moody City Hall support our efforts.
