Consultation

Corporate Policy – 04-1470-01 – Compensation for Voluntary Consultation was approved on October 27, 2009 to clarify that the City does not compensate any party for voluntary consultation on its land use and management plans such as the Official Community Plan, rezoning applications or capital projects. This policy is now no longer considered necessary as the City's standard practice is not to compensate other parties, including other governments, unless a specific agreement has been created for this purpose.

As such, staff recommend the following:
