Compensation for Voluntary Consultation

Policy

The City of Port Moody does not compensate any party – including, but not limited to, local and senior governments, interested third parties, and the general public – for voluntary consultation on its land use and management plans.

Definitions

Land use and management plans includes, but is not limited to, Official Community Plans, rezoning, capital projects, and other activities where the City of Port Moody either voluntarily, or as required by legislation or other levels of government, provides consultation opportunities to the general public, other agencies, and groups.

Procedures

Staff will decline any invoices or requests for compensation where the City undertakes a consultation process where participation by those consulted is voluntary.
