Subject: Union of BC Municipalities Membership Renewal 2023

The City of Port Moody is currently a member of the Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM), which represents and serves all local governments in BC by advocating for common interests.

An invoice for 2023 Membership is included with this memo. The 2023 annual UBCM dues for the City of Port Moody are calculated based on population that is currently 36,786, therefore the dues are \$14,712.51 for 2023. These membership dues are budgeted for each year. For reference, the City of Port Moody paid \$14,366.44 for the annual membership in 2022. It is recommended that Council renew the City of Port Moody's membership in the UBCM with the following resolution:
