Subject: Proposed Development Cost Charges Expenditure Bylaw – Inlet Park

Redevelopment Project

Pursuant to section 566 of the *Local Government Act* (*LGA*), a Development Cost Charge (DCC) paid to a local government must be deposited in a separate special DCC reserve fund established for each purpose for which the local government imposes the DCC. This DCC reserve fund was established by the City through Bylaw No. 1595, 1983. The *LGA* also states that funds collected in the DCC reserves can be only used on projects identified in the City's DCC program, and municipalities must authorize this expenditure through a bylaw.

The Inlet Park Redevelopment Project is included in the City's DCC program that was approved by the Province in 2019. This capital project budget was approved at \$8,700,000 in the program, and confirmation of funding sources, including approved Provincial/Federal grant program, was confirmed in 2022. After considering the municipal contribution of approximately 25% of total projected cost, the estimated DCC to be collected for this project is \$1,915,000.

To replace and enhance the Inlet Field site, the Inlet Park Redevelopment Project scope includes a new FIFA regulation artificial turf field, which also includes three Super 8 youth sports fields, two baseball and softball diamonds, two new integrated playgrounds, new parking lot and walking path connections to the surrounding inlet trails. Other site enhancements include drainage improvements, new boardwalk and pathway, new fencing and restoration planting.

Draft City of Port Moody Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2023, No. 3418 (Inlet Park Redevelopment Project) (**Attachment 1**)—a Bylaw to appropriate for expenditure from the Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund for the purpose of paying the costs of civil construction contract works at Inlet Park—is attached for Council's consideration of first, second, and third readings. The recommended resolution is:

Bylaw No. 3418

A Bylaw to appropriate for expenditure from the Development Cost Charge (DCC) Reserve Fund for the purpose of paying the capital costs of the construction works at Inlet Park.

WHEREAS the City's Development Cost Charge (DCC) Reserve Fund was established under City of Port Moody Development Cost Charges Imposition By-law, 1983, No. 1595, ("Reserve Fund)" to fund the capital costs of water, sewage, highway and drainage facilities, and public open spaces ("parks");

AND WHEREAS the amount of \$9,317,000 as of June 29, 2023, is unallocated and available in the Reserve Fund for the purpose of Parks;

AND WHEREAS the amount of \$1,915,000 is estimated to be the cost of financing the DCC eligible capital cost for capital improvements at Inlet Park;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Port Moody enacts as follows:

1. Citation

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as "City of Port Moody Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2023, No. 3418 (Inlet Park Redevelopment Project)".

2. Appropriation

- 2.1 The sum of \$1,915,000 is hereby appropriated for expenditure from the Reserve Fund for the purpose of paying the capital costs of completing capital improvements at Inlet Park.
- 2.2 Any of the above amount that remains unexpended after the purpose of section 2.1 has been fulfilled will be returned to the credit of the Reserve Fund.

3. Severability

3.1 If a portion of this Bylaw is found invalid by a court, it will be severed and the remainder of the Bylaw will remain in effect.
