Subject: New Stream and Drainage Bylaw, No. 3426 – Adoption

At the Regular Council meeting held on October 24, 2023, Council considered a memo from the Legislative Services Division regarding New Stream and Drainage Bylaw, No. 3426 – Three Readings (**Attachment 1**) and passed the following resolution:

RC23/261 (Consent)

THAT City of Port Moody Stream and Drainage Bylaw, 2023, No. 3426 be read a first, second, and third time as recommended in the memo dated October 24, 2023, from the Legislative Services Division regarding New Stream and Drainage Bylaw, No. 3426 – Three Readings.

City of Port Moody Stream and Drainage Bylaw, 2023, No. 3426 (**Attachment 2**)—a bylaw to a) protect the drainage system from damage, obstruction, interference, unauthorized use, alteration, or the release of prohibited materials; b) protect the City of Port Moody’s employees, infrastructure, environment, and the public from exposure to dangerous conditions; c) protect, control, and monitor the volume and ensure that an acceptable quality of water enters the drainage system; and d) provide for a system of permits and permissions that impose conditions on releases to the drainage system—will be before Council for consideration of adoption at the Regular Council meeting of November 14, 2023.

The recommended resolution is:

THAT City of Port Moody Stream and Drainage Bylaw, 2023, No. 3426 be now adopted as recommended in the memo dated November 14, 2023, from the Legislative Services Division regarding New Stream and Drainage Bylaw, No. 3426 – Adoption.
