Subject: Video Surveillance Corporate Policy

The City of Port Moody is subject to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (*FIPPA*) and, as such, is committed to ensuring the protection of privacy through responsible personal information management practices including the use of video surveillance technology in the City of Port Moody.

The City currently employs video surveillance equipment at some of its facilities and at specific locations in public spaces (such as for traffic and wildlife monitoring). In addition, some new City initiatives and programs in the future may also require the use of video surveillance. In both cases, the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner (OIPC) recommends that the City enact a comprehensive policy for video surveillance to ensure compliance with *FIPPA*.

Presented for Council's approval is the draft Video Surveillance Corporate Policy, which outlines the parameters and responsibilities for the collection, access to, use, and disclosure of personal information recorded by video surveillance equipment.

The recommended resolution is:

THAT Corporate Policy – 01-0580-2023-01 – Video Surveillance be approved as attached to the memo dated November 28, 2023, from the Legislative Services Division regarding Video Surveillance Corporate Policy.
