Bylaw No. 3443

A Bylaw to amend the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw to align with Stream and Drainage Bylaw, 2023, No. 3426.

The Council of the City of Port Moody enacts as follows:

1. Citation

- 1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as "City of Port Moody Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw, 2020, No. 3218, Amendment Bylaw No. 13, 2024, No. 3443.
