#### 6.1 Coastal Flood Strategy Update

Presentation: Corporate Planning Advisor Presentation to be distributed on-table

The Corporate Planning Advisor gave a presentation entitled "Climate Action Committee" and referred to slides contained within the on-table package.

- clarification regarding the complexity of public information that will be included in the Coastal Flood Strategy;

- concern for the sensitivity of residential impacts in the strategy;

- desire to collaborate with other municipalities exploring climate action plans.
