6.4 Archival Feasibility Study- initial discussions

Verbal Report: Manager of Policy Planning and Robyn Biggar

Staff gave a presentation entitled "Archival Feasibility Study Discussion" and referred to slides contained within the on-table package.

Committee discussion ensued regarding the following topics:

- the desire to have greater retention and public accessibility of historical records;
- the nature of the website as a tool but not an official repository of records;
- the possible use of Artificial Intelligence to improve public accessibility to records;
- the expected timeframe or next steps on this project;
- desire for information, engagement with stakeholders, and approaches and general costing;
- the desire to include a consultant to help in making decisions;
- the possibility of an individual with knowledge to speak to the committee on the matter; and
- the desire to have plentiful community engagement involved in the creation of an archive.
