6.1 Moray Street Traffic Calming Design

The Transportation Engineer gave a presentation entitled “Moray Street Traffic Calming Update” and referred to slides contained in the on-table package.

Committee discussion ensued regarding the following topics:

- access to James Road;
- speed traffic calming projects;
- consideration to renew pilot project infrastructure in place of permanent infrastructure;
- replacement of delineators and use of delineators made of alternative materials;
- alternative locations for bike routes;
- challenges with the design; and
- challenges with right turn exist only.
