Subject: Supporting transparency through reporting on city meetings with industry

representatives – Motion Served by Councillor Haven Lurbiecki

Notice of the following motion was provided at the July 23, 2024, Regular Council meeting:

THAT staff report back with a list of meetings between staff and industry representatives and/or lobby organizations within the last 24 months including:

- details on these meetings such as membership, purpose, specific topics of discussion, and;
- a list of any Port Moody policies or bylaws that have been reviewed at any of these meetings and if any changes to policy have been made resulting from these meetings.

Background

During the July 16, 2024 City Initiatives and Planning Committee meeting the public heard reference for the first time to a 'Development Liaison Committee'. This occurred when a motion was moved during the meeting that the item being considered (timeline to advance Energy Step Code and Zero Carbon Step Code) be sent to the 'Development Liason Committee' for input/engagement. Membership of the Development Liason Committee was not provided during the July 16th committee meeting.

Currently no reporting mechanism exists for where and when the development or other industry representatives or lobby organizations have had opportunity to influence city policy, approaches and/or bylaws in Port Moody. The purpose of this memo is to request this information.

There is immense public interest in the city's approaches to housing and development because of the potential impacts of these approaches on the community. Opportunities for greater information sharing serve to increase transparency and enhance public trust.
