The City of Port Moody Engineering and Operations Department prepared the report titled Guildford Way Bicycle Facility Improvements Project for the October 8, 2024 Regular Council meeting. The report provides an analysis of crashes at the intersection of Guildford Way and loco Road along with recommendations to improve safety and reduce conflicts between pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles. It also includes findings from a traffic modelling study aimed at minimizing impacts on drivers and improving vehicle flow along the Guildford Way corridor between the Coquitlam border and loco Road.

The recommendations in this report are based on professional engineering analysis and judgment with the goal of improving safety, reducing conflicts, and minimizing disruptions to drivers.
