6.1 Master Transportation Plan Overview and Status

Verbal Report: Staff

The Manager of Infrastructure Engineering gave a presentation titled " Master Transportation Plan Update" and referred to slides contained within the agenda package.

- curbside management strategies;
- SkyTrain station location considerations;
- parking management strategies such as multi-family resident parking passes;
- enforcement;
- parking costs;
- TransLink authority over road usage; and
- opportunities for the committee to support the plan such as through feedback on the "5 Big Moves" projects.

6.2 St. Johns Street Redesign Phase 2 – Transportation Modelling

Presentation: Staff

The Manager of Infrastructure Engineering gave a presentation entitled "St. Johns Street Redesign - Phase 2; Moody Street to loco Road" and referred to slides contained within the on-table package.

Committee discussion ensued regarding the following:

- challenges to buses crossing lanes to turn left;
- curbside management strategies and loss of parking;
- detailed design concerns, timelines, and processes to accommodate access to connecting roads;
- options and considerations for existing driveways in light of the planned bike lanes on St. Johns;
- the opportunity to leverage grants as part of a budget; and
- cycling infrastructure coordination with adjacent municipalities.
