Purpose

To provide Council with information regarding a resolution passed by the Seniors Focus Committee requesting the implementation of Stroke Recovery Association of BC Community Programs.

Background

At the March 5, 2020 Seniors Focus Committee meeting, the Committee received a presentation from the Regional Manager of the Stroke Recovery Association of BC and learned of the opportunity to provide programs for stroke survivors in the community. The Committee passed the following resolution:

<u>SFC20/007</u>

THAT the Stroke Recovery Association community programs be explored and considered for application to Port Moody.

Discussion

Members of the Seniors Focus Committee discussed the programs available in both Coquitlam and Port Coquitlam and noted that no programs are currently available in Port Moody. The Regional Manager advised that programs can be run in partnership with municipalities at relatively low costs, and that the job duties can be undertaken by an appropriate City employee such as a Recreation Programmer. The Seniors Focus Committee noted that making programs and services more accessible in Port Moody would provide stroke survivors access to achieving their recovery goals in their own community.
