

Draft Criteria for a new Civic Award – Youth Sports Award

The Youth Sports Award recognizes local youth who demonstrate achievement in their chosen sport(s) as well as additional qualities such as leadership or academic excellence.

CRITERIA:

Nominees must:

1. have been a resident of Port Moody at the time of the noted achievement or reason for nomination;
2. be aged 12 to 19 years old;
3. be actively participating in high-performance sport through performance, coaching, officiating, or administration/management;
4. be identifiable under at least one (1) of the three (3) secondary categories:
 - **leadership qualities** — demonstrating the qualities of leadership, coachability, and a strong work ethic, and the characteristics of fair play both on and off the field;
 - **education** — demonstrating a commitment to academic studies and continued education; and/or
 - **future goals** — demonstrating how their experience in sport is shaping their future.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

1. The nomination will be included in the Civic Awards nomination process.
2. Each nomination must be supported by two (2) separate nominators or references.
3. The submission of attachments is encouraged to support nominations and may include photos, media clips, medals, jerseys, trophies, etc. (or photos/copies of these items).
4. The winner will be invited to attend the City's Committee Volunteer Dinner to receive the award.
5. The winner will be presented with the award.
