What Do You Think About Building Large Homes in Port Moody?

City Council has created a Port Moody House Size and Siting Task Force to evaluate public concerns related to large homes, with a particular (though not exclusive) focus on the Pleasantside neighbourhood. - 1) Are Port Moody's current bylaws limiting home size and lot siting appropriate and sufficient at this point, in your view? Why or why not? [Text field Max. 500 words]
- 2) Do any new or recently constructed houses raise concerns for you? If so, why? If possible, please include the street address of any houses you wish to cite. Also, feel free to upload a photo (max 5mb), tell us whether or not you live nearby, and be specific about what may concern you. [Text field – max 300 words]
- 3) If you are a neighbour of the house in question: Did its owner/builder consult you prior to construction, what did that involve, and do you feel that your input was taken into account in the final home design? If so, how? [Text field max 300 words]
- 4) Would you suggest any improvements to the required <u>neighbour feedback process</u> [link] for home-building applicants? Please be specific. [Text field]
- 5) How would you balance the rights of new-home builders versus neighbours? To strike the right balance between the property owner's right to build the home they want, on the one hand, and the community's right to protect neighbourhood character and the interests of others, on the other, do current bylaws seem sufficient to you, or would you recommend a different approach? [Text field]

6) Would you limit house size? If so, how much? Under current bylaws for single-family homes in a standard zone, a house may have a maximum FAR (floor-area ratio) of 0.5, meaning the floor area cannot exceed 50% of the lot area, which may vary from one lot to the next. An alternate approach might be to put a *fixed limit* on total square footage: if the City were to consider setting a fixed home size limit, what's your view?
