The Sustainability and Energy Coordinator gave a presentation on the Sustainability Report Card Review, including the purpose of the Report Card, the City's Sustainability Pillars, the current uses and processes of the Report Card, and feedback and concerns received so far.

The Committee noted the following:

- the current report card is very well organized, and simple to look at:
- it would be helpful to provide applicants with an example of a completed review to make applicants more confident in their response;
- the Report Card should emphasize the need for better ventilation and insulation in buildings;
- the Report Card should include a section on energy efficiency, encourage more efficient lighting sources to reduce electricity use, and encourage efficient home heating systems; and
- the Report Card should encourage more (green) spaces for physical activity, to facilitate working and schooling from home.
