

Draft Criteria for a new Civic Award – Youth Environmental Award

The Youth Environmental Award recognizes local youth that advances environmental preservation and awareness in the City of Port Moody.

CRITERIA:

Nominees must:

1. have been a resident of Port Moody at the time of the noted achievement or reason for nomination;
2. be aged 12 to 19 years old;

We evaluate nominees based on their project or initiative within one or more of the following areas:

- Ecological Initiative
- Habitat Enhancement
- Naturescape Principles
- Volunteerism and Engagement
- Environmental Education and Outreach
- Waste Reduction
- Water Use Reduction
- Energy Efficiency
- Greenhouse Gas Emission Reduction
- Climate Change

NOMINATION PROCESS:

1. The nomination will be included in the Civic Awards nomination process.
2. The submission of attachments is encouraged to support nominations and may include photos, media clips, medals, jerseys, trophies, etc. (or photos/copies of these items).
3. The Environmental Protection Committee will review the nomination and make a recommendation to Council.
4. The winner will be invited to attend the City's Committee Volunteer Dinner to receive the award.
5. The winner will be presented with the award.
