11. Verbal Reports from Council and Staff

11.1 Council Verbal Reports

Councillor Lubik thanked Council for its accomplishments this year, and thanked the community for coming together during a difficult time. Councillor Lubik noted that this is a good time to learn about traditions and celebrations from other religions and cultures. Councillor Lubik noted that the SHARE Family and Community Services and the Phoenix Society are accepting donations, and the Tri-Cities Amnesty International Write for Rights event will take place virtually on December 10, 2020. Councillor Lubik thanked staff for their work this year.

Councillor Dilworth acknowledged being on the unceded territories of Coast Salish First Nations, and thanked staff, Council, and the community for working through difficult situations. Councillor Dilworth encouraged residents to support and share with those in need, and committed to working with Council for the best interests of the community. Councillor Dilworth offered her best wishes for the holidays.

Councillor Royer thanked staff for their work and wished everyone a safe holiday.

Councillor Milani reminded residents to complete the Housing Needs Survey and to donate toys and non-perishable food items at City Hall and the Inlet Centre Fire Hall, and wished residents a safe and happy holiday season.

Councillor Madsen wished residents a happy holiday.

Mayor Vagramov wished residents a good holiday season and a happy new year, and encouraged residents to keep track of holiday events in the context of shifting provincial regulations.

Mayor Vagramov noted that the CP Holiday Train will take place virtually on Saturday, December 12, 2020.

11.2 Staff Verbal Reports

The City Manager provided an update on the Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) Management Strategy update, including the following:

- the purpose of the update is to accurately map the City's natural areas and features, align the strategy with existing federal, provincial, and local regulations, and modernize development permit area guidelines;
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESAs) will be renamed Environmental Development Permit Areas (EDPAs);
- the update is intended to mitigate the environmental impact of development, within 30m of riparian ESAs, 30m upland from the high-water mark, and within 15m of forest ESAs;
- assessment areas are not related to Zoning Bylaw setbacks;
- the next step is the development of a comprehensive communications and public engagement strategy, with the assistance of the SFU Centre for Dialogue; and
- there will be opportunities for the public to provide input.

13. Public Input

Brian Krieger (Port Moody) expressed concerns regarding the noise generated by the usage of a basketball court adjacent to Chestnut Way, and requested the relocation of the basketball hoop to a more appropriate location. Mr. Krieger also expressed concerns about the installation of pickleball courts nearby, which was done without consultation.

Barry Sharbo (Port Moody) thanked Eagle Ridge Hospital staff and health care workers.
