Subject: FCM Membership Renewal 2021

The City of Port Moody is currently a member of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM), which represents and serves over 2,000 Canadian municipalities by advocating for common interests with the Government of Canada's departments and agencies.

The 2021 Annual FCM dues for the City of Port Moody, calculated based on population with a base fee, are \$7,493.07. These membership dues were included in the annual budget.

For reference, the City of Port Moody paid annual membership fees of \$7,236.04 for 2020, \$5,757.33 in 2019, and \$5,602.39 in 2018. The optional contributions were not paid.
