February	<u>EPC20/006</u> THAT Council direct staff to provide outreach and educational information on bird mortality during 2020 Bird Week.	2020 Bird Week was impacted by COVID-19.
May	<u>EPC20/009</u> THAT Salmon-Safe standards be included in the Environmental Section of the Sustainability Report Card.	Council adopted the Committee's resolution in June, and it has also been included as Committee feedback as part of the Council-directed Sustainability Report Card review process.
September	<u>EPC20/015</u> THAT the Environmental Protection Committee endorse the updates to the Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESA) Management Strategy for presentation to Council.	The ESA Management Strategy is currently in consultation phase which was extended.
November	<u>EPC20/022</u> THAT the Environmental Protection Committee recommend that Council direct staff to explore forest and nature therapy opportunities as part of the Urban Forest Management Strategy.	The resolution will be forwarded to Council for consideration in January 2021.
